### Creativity and efficacy in systemic clinical work and research

"Rigor alone is paralytic death, but imagination alne is insanity" [G.Bateson, 1972]

Creativity and efficacy seem to be located at opposite poles because creativity represents freedom of expression, inventiveness, spontaneity, intuition, art, innovation, while efficacy is the result, the measure, the effect. Can these two elements coexist in systemic clinical work research? In collaboration with colleagues from HESTAFTA and under the patronage of EFTA CIM, SIRTS (Italian Society of Systemic Research and Therapy-www.sirts.or) intends to take on the task and the challenge of putting into dialogue the rigorous description of therapeutic processes, that allow a comparability and replicability, with the possibility of enhancing the uniqueness and creativity of the intervention. In a historical moment in which the need of "evidence-based" proposals is ever more strongly resonant, SIRTS promotes a comparison with experts in the care work that also refer to different theoretical premises, to understand how to remain anchored to subjectivity and complexity of the systemic approach that are difficult to measure according to the criteria of "evidence-based medicine". The Congress will welcome contributions that, in dissimilar institutional contexts and different settings, aim to "hold together" creative developments and rigorous methodologies.
